The Township of Perth South in partnership with the City of Stratford is pleased to continue to offer a Hazardous Waste Collection Program for 2020:

Perth South Residents are welcome to bring in your Hazardous waste to the City of Stratford Landfill site located at 777 Romeo St. South on the following dates during regular landfill hours.

Materials will be accepted at the landfill on:

April 25th

May 30th

June 27th

July 25th

August 29th

September 26th



Small quantity generators can bring in a maximum of 100 kg of hazardous waste (this includes maximum 10 fluorescent light bulbs and tubes). All containers must not exceed 20 litre (5 Gallon) containers and must be in original labeled containers.

What is Hazardous Waste?

- Paints, coatings and containers
- Solvents
- Motor oil and filters (contact Stratford Public Works 519 271 0250 ext. 259)
- Batteries
- Antifreeze
- Pharmaceuticals and Sharps (in puncture proof screw top container)
- Propane tanks
- Fluorescent tubes and bulbs (limit 10)
- Pesticides and lawn fertilizers
- Household Cleaners
- Fire Extinguishers

We do not accept PCB waste, Radioactive waste, Flares, fireworks and ammunition, Pathological waste, Open or leaky containers

Identification will be required at the Stratford Landfill Site
