

TOWNSHIP OF PERTH SOUTH

BY-LAW NO. 27-2010

Being a By-law to provide for the regulation of off-road vehicles and motorized snow vehicles.

WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Perth South deems it in the public interest to regulate the operation of off-road vehicles and motorized snow vehicles.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Township of Perth South **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **THAT** Interpretation be defined as follows:
 - (a) **Highway** includes a common and public highway, street, avenue, public lane, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct, or trestle, designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles.
 - (b) **Low pressure bearing tire** means a wide, balloon-type tire with a rounded cross section and no distinct shoulder area and that is designed to operate with inflation pressure of no greater than 70 kpa (10psi).
 - (c) **Motorized snow vehicle** means a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven primarily on snow.
 - (d) **Off-road vehicle** means an off-road vehicle within the meaning of the *Off-Road Vehicles Act*, R.S.O. 199, c.12, Sched R.s. 17: 2002, c.17, Sched.F, Table.
2. **THAT** subject to the provisions of this by-law motorized snow vehicles and an off-road vehicle with three or more wheels and low pressure bearing tires may be operated on any highway within, and under the jurisdiction of the Township of Perth South.
3. **THAT** a motorized snow vehicle or an off-road vehicle shall not be operated on any sidewalks in the Township of Perth South other than for the purpose of crossing sidewalks when travelling from private property to the roadway.


4. **THAT** no person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle or an off-road with three or more wheels and low pressure bearing tires in any area where a sign is posted prohibiting such operation.
5. **THAT** no person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle or an off-road vehicle with three or more wheels and low pressure bearing tires at a speed greater than:
 - (a) 20 kilometers per hour, if the speed limit established for that part of the highway is not greater than 50 kilometers per hour; or
 - (b) 50 kilometers per hour, if the speed limit established for that part of the highway is greater than 50 kilometers per hour.
6. **THAT** the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to the provisions of the *Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chap. H8*, and amendments thereto, the *Off-Road Vehicles Act, R.S.O. 1990, C.0.4*, and amendments thereto.
7. **THAT** any person found in contravention of this by-law is guilty of an offense and upon conviction is liable to a fine of \$110.00 excluding court costs.

READ a FIRST and SECOND TIME this 18th day of May, 2010.

READ a THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED this 18th day of May, 2010.

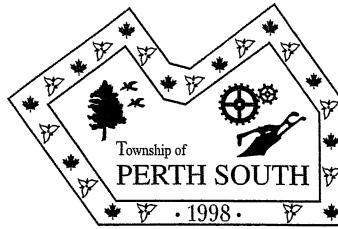
