OPEN-AIR CONTROLLED BURN REQUIREMENTS:

1. **Notification:** The Fire Chief must be notified of the intent to conduct an Open-Air Controlled Burn at least 30 minutes prior to ignition. This notification must be made by the owner or the owner's designate, who must be at least eighteen (18) years old.
2. **Approval:** Property owners must obtain verbal confirmation of approval for the controlled burn from the Fire Department before proceeding. No person shall ignite or maintain an open-air controlled burn without obtaining this permission.
3. **Supervision:** The open-air fire must be supervised by a responsible person at all times. The fire must not be left unattended until it is completely extinguished.
4. **Burn Timing:** Open-air fires are permitted only between sunrise and sunset.
5. **Location:** Burning is restricted to the location approved by the Fire Chief as indicated on the Open-Air Controlled Burn form.
6. **Weather Conditions:** Fires are only allowed if weather conditions are favorable, ensuring that the fire will not spread or cause harm.
7. **Materials:** Only materials specified on the Open-Air Controlled Burn form are allowed to be burned. Burning of petroleum products, materials containing rubbish, or materials that create obnoxious odors is prohibited.
8. **Control Measures:** There must be adequate means to control and extinguish the fire, such as a fire extinguisher or other suitable fire suppression equipment.
9. **Liability:** The owner shall be solely liable for any and all damage resulting from the open-air burn. A copy of the Open-Air Fire By-law is available at the Municipal Office and online at www.perthsouth.ca.
