

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PERTH SOUTH
BY-LAW #25-2004

"BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE, RESTRICT AND CONTROL THE USE OF THE
WASTE DISPOSAL AREAS"

Amending All Previous By-laws

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 210, paragraph 135 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990 Chapter M.45, as amended, a Municipal Council has the authority to control land used for the disposal of refuse;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Perth South deems it in the public's best interest to establish a system for the separation, collection or disposition and processing of waste and recyclable materials;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Perth South ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

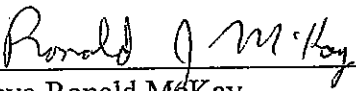
1. That the waste disposal areas known as 3825 Perth Road 130, more particularly described as Part of Lot 15, Concession 2, Downie Ward and 1591 Perth Road 139, more particularly described as Part of Lot 18, Concession East Mitchell Road, Blanshard Ward, Perth South be for the use of Perth South residents for waste generated within Perth South Township only;
2. That all refuse shall be placed in the location indicated by the custodian in charge;
3. Any recyclable materials brought to the waste disposal site for burying rather than recycling shall be refused;
4. A tipping fee shall be charged for waste brought to the landfill sites and certain regulations shall apply, as set out in Schedule "A" of this By-law;
5. The following kinds of wastes shall be prohibited:
 - a) freon or appliances that contain freon;
 - b) woven wire, barbed wire, wire cages;
 - c) toxic chemical wastes, herbicides, pesticides, or other poisonous products, explosive materials or containers liable to explode;
 - d) liquid or solid sewage, including septic tank pumpings;
 - e) dead animals, feces, large stumps and field stones;
 - f) abandoned vehicles, including farm machinery, or other bulky wastes;
 - g) chimney bricks, roofing (including asphalt shingles), foundation materials resulting from the construction, renovation, repair and/or demolition of any building;
 - h) oil and gas tanks removed from the ground, contaminated soil;

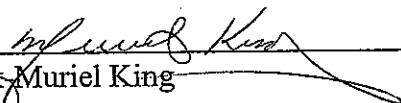
j) other materials which in the opinion of the custodian at the waste disposal site, may cause a nuisance or health hazard or cannot be safely or conveniently incorporated into the landfill operation;

6. That the Blanshard Ward landfill site be open the first Saturday of the month from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.;
7. That the Downie Ward landfill site be open the second Saturday of the month from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.;
8. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law, upon conviction, shall forfeit and pay at the direction of the convicting Magistrate a penalty not less than \$1,000.00 and not more than \$2,000.00 exclusive of costs, for the first offence, and not more than \$5,000.00 for subsequent offences, exclusive of costs in all cases;
9. This By-law shall come into force and take effect with the final passing thereof and shall repeal all previous By-laws affecting landfill use on these properties.

READ A FIRST AND SECOND TIME THIS 17 DAY OF February, 2004.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 17 DAY OF February, 2004.

Schedule "A" to By-law #25-2004

Tipping Fee Schedule & Regulations

Minimum fee \$5.00 or at discretion of the Landfill Custodian/Site Manager
\$20.00 minimum for 1/2 ton truck load
Larger loads at the discretion of the Landfill Custodian/Site Manager
Maximum Fee of \$200.00

Tires \$5.00 each
\$10.00 larger tires, \$20.00 tractor tires

ABSOLUTELY NO BAGGED GARBAGE - No household garbage will be accepted at the waste disposal sites that is suitable for curbside pick up.

Bins not accepted at the waste disposal sites.

Waste acceptable at the waste disposal sites at the discretion of the attendant.

FOR BURNABLE MATERIALS: A special rate of \$5.00 per cubic metre shall be charged for all burnable items brought to the Blanshard Landfill Site.
