Winter Driving Tips

It is important to be prepared for winter driving. These tips can help make your winter driving safer:

- Ensure that your car is winter ready by getting a maintenance check up on your car.

- Ensure that you have an ice-scraper in your car and washer fluid that works down to -40 degrees.

- A winter survival kit is a wise item to have in your car in case you get into a bad situation. Items that should be included in your kit are: a charged phone, water and non-perishable food, flashlight, blanket or warm clothes, jumper cables, a shovel, traction mats or sand, candles and a lighter or matches.

- Putting winter tires on your vehicle improves traction and control.

- Before you leave home check the weather forecast. If inclement weather is in the forecast, delay your trip if you can.

- Before you go anywhere always make sure you clear ice from windows, lights, mirrors and the roof of your car.

- While on the road slow down and stay in control, make sure you are looking ahead at all times.

- If you skid, release your brakes and steer in the direction you want to go.

- Never pass a snow plow

- Keep your distance behind snow plows
